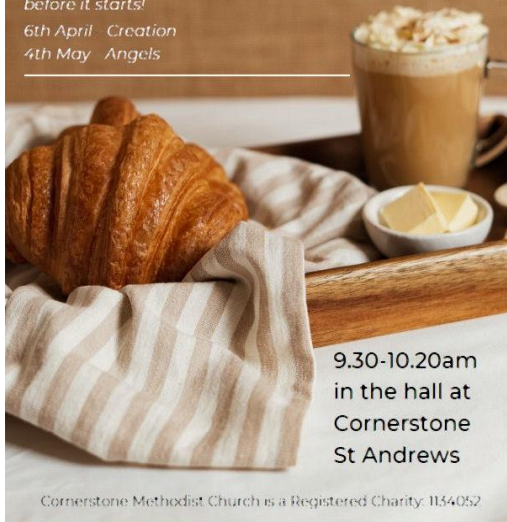

As you know, all three chapels at Cornerstone have achieved an Ecochurch Bronze award and we now need to start the journey for silver. This will entail working on three surveys, one for each chapel. Many of the questions will be answered in the same way for all three but the sections on Buildings and Land will need to be worked on separately.

I need a team of at least three people - one for each chapel. I am willing to be responsible for London Road so I am looking for volunteers to represent St Andrew's and Partridge Green. I envisage the team meeting about once a month to update the surveys and highlight next steps.
